

Kokoda Triticale

Dual-purpose triticale

- Sown early mid-March to end of April
- Good early dry matter production
- Excellent late dry matter production
- Semi-awnless – can be used for hay production.

Graze to the end of July.

High grain yield

- an average 9% better than Endeavour
- **Excellent disease resistant package (NVT ratings 2020, 2021 and 2022).**
 - Stem rust resistant(R)
 - Leaf rust resistant (RMR)
 - Stripe rust resistant (RMR)^(Response to unknown or rare pathotype unknown).
 - Septoria tritici blotch resistant(MR)
 - Yellow Spot resistant (MR)
 - Cereal Cyst Nematode resistant (R)
 - Crown Rot moderately susceptible (MS)
 - Flag Smut resistant (R)
 - Bunt resistant (R)
- **Improved metabolizable energy** - for pigs and poultry, **increased levels of starch and protein, and lower fibre levels** compared to Endeavour over 3 sites and 1 year of trials.
